

FAQ'S

Related to Eng/Farm Science/pharma Courses

- 1** I am a PIO/OCI/NRI candidates, AM I Eligible for ENGINEERING Seats through KCET ?
 - * No, you are not eligible. This rules are applicable only for Indian citizens only.

- 2** My parents are from Karnataka, they have studied in Karnataka for a minimum period of 7 years and if I have passed 11th & 12th from Karnataka will I eligible to claim a seats in Karnataka ?
 - * Yes, If your either of the parents have studied in Karnataka for a minimum period of **7 years** . If you have passed 11th&12th std from Karnataka you can claim a seat under clause code 'b'

- 3** My parents are from Karnataka, we have been residing outside & I have studied completely outside the Karnataka will I eligible to claim a seat?
 - * If either of your parents are from Karnataka,& was domiciled in Karnataka & also your mother tongue is Kannada/Tulu/Kodava you can claim a seat through KCET under clause code 'c' & establishing the Mother tongue. And the candidate should undergo kannada language test in which candidate should get minimum 12 marks out of 50 marks.

- 4** My father is a defence personal and are from non Karnataka presently working in Karnataka from last 3 years, but I have to come for Karnataka to study 12th std in the month of october, of the last academic year and have passed 12th std in Karnataka will i be eligible under clause code 'e'?
 - * Under clause code 'e' the candidate should have joined the college/ institution in the month of 1st July of the academic year and passed the Qualifying Examination in Karnataka. Since you have joined the college in the month of october,you are not eligible.

- 5** I have studied in Karnataka from 1St to 7th std, Am I eligible to take Engineering/ Agriculture/any other courses seats from KCET, under clause code 'a'.
 - * Under clause code 'a' If you have studied upt to 7th std only from Karnataka You are not eligible to claim a seat from KCET. Yours 7 years study in Karnataka should have included 10 or 12th Std.

- 6** I have studied in Rural area of Karnataka from 1st to 8th std am I eligible to claim Rural Quota seats from KCET?
- * No, you cannot claim because the candidate should have studied in rural area (which is having less than 50,000 population) from 1st to 10th std to claim the rural Quota seats from KCET.
- 7** I Have studied in Kannada medium from 1st to 9th std. Am I eligible to Kannada medium Quota seats in KCET?
- * You should have studied in Kannada medium from 1st to 10th std completely, otherwise you will not be eligible.
- 8** I have studied 1st to 10th std in Karnataka in which I have studied 10th std in English medium & have taken 2 years to pass 9th std will I be eligible to claim Kannada medium?
- * No, any candidate have taken more than one year to pass any Std that will be taken as one complete year only, Since you have passed 10th std in English medium you cannot claim Kannada medium Quota seat.
- 9** I have studied in outside Karnataka from 1st to 12th std in Kannada medium will I eligible to take a seat from KCET?
- * Yes if you have studied in Kannada medium in any state of the country & if you are a Indian citizen you are eligible to take CET Examination claim the seat from KCET.
- 10** I am a J&K migrant, Am I eligible to claim Eng & other seat from KCET?
- * Yes, If you are a migrant of J&K, & If you have a valid migrant certificate issued by the Competent authority("District Magistrate and Deputy Commissioner"), you can claim a seat from KCET under clause code M.
- 11** I am a NCC 'A' certificate holder and I have studied in Karnataka complete 12years will I eligible to claim NCC Quota in Engineering/Ayush/ Farm Science /pharma-D etc?
- * Even if you have studied completely in Karnataka and having only 'A' certificate, you are not eligible.
The candidate should have passed certificates 'B' or above issued by Competent authority.
- 12** I am a Karnataka candidate, I have studied 12years in Karnataka only & I have participated in state level sports & having medal also can I claim the Sports Quota seats?
- * Even if you have studied in Karnataka & participated in state level games & got medal also you are not eligible.
Only National level & above participation /medals holding candidates can claim the Sports quota

13 I am clause code 'C' candidate and I am having 2 International medals, which represented from Tamil Nadu, will I eligible to claim sports Quota seats from Karnataka ?

* No, the candidate should have represented from Karnataka then only he/she can claim the Sports Quota seats.

14 How do you determine the merit for Engineering course?

* For Engineering 50% from the Q.E marks of PCM & 50% from the entrance marks of PCM subjects.

15 What is the Qualifying Examination minimum marks to determine the rank from Engineering in case of General Merit?

* In case of General Merit 45% in PCM Subject for SC/ST/OBC is 40%.

Reservation

1 When can we apply reservation?

- * At the time of submitting online application students need to mention the eligible reservations. However they have to produce the relevant reservation certificate on the day of document verifications.

2 What is the Income limit for SC/ST/CAT1 candidates for claiming their reservation in Eng/Ayush/Farm Science/etc?

- * To claim a seat under reservation for the above courses there is No income limit for SC/ST/CAT -1 .

3 Is SC,ST/ Cat-1 candidates also should produce Income Certificate?

- * For claiming reservation income certificate not required. But as per Government order to claim fees concession he/she has to compulsarily submit income certificate in addition to caste certificate.

4 What is the Income limit for the 2A,2B,3A&3B category candidates to claim Engineering/Farm science/etc seats ?

- * As per the revised Govt order family income limit for 2A,2B,3A & 3B category reservation claim seats in Engineering/Farm Science/etc seats is 8 lakhs. And you should have got certificate issued by Jurisdictional Thasildar to that effect.

5 For Kannada & Rural Quota reservation is the BEO counter signature is compulsory in study certificate?

- * Yes, for Kannada & rural Quota reservation compulsarily you should have got counter signature from the BEO.

6 What is 371(J) reservation?

- * The Govt of Karnataka has provided this Special reservation under article 371(J) for the candidates/parents who are coming under Hyderabad Karnataka Area like Kalburgi, Bidar, Yadgiri, Koppala, Raichur & Bellary(6 district). These candidates are eligible to claim this reservation by producing 371(J) certificate issued by the Asst. Commissioner of the Said division/district .
- 7** If I had mentioned any category/reservation, & failed to submit the reservation certificate during verification candidature rejected?
- * If you have mentioned during online application and if you are unable to produce during documents verification your candidature will not be rejected, But your concerned reservation will not be considered and you will be treated as non reserve candidate(for that particular reservation).
- 8** When I mentioned wrong category /reservation during online application, filling Is there any chance to change it before document verification?
- * After the last date of filling application , Editing option will be provided within the given time candidate can edit any data earlier given including the category/reservation. After the last date of editing candidate can not change /alter the any data including reservation /category.
- 9** What is SNQ?
- * SNQ means (Super numerary Quota) which is available only PU based Engineering stream. The candidates who's family income is below 8 lakh are eligible to claim this quota. All the category candidates including GM candidates are also eligible for Super numerary Quota(SNQ)
- 10** How is the SNQ seats is allotted?
- * Although Income limit is 8lakh allotment will be based on candidates having 1 lakh first, then 2lakh next,3lakh next like that it continues.
- 11** For 7 years study certificate BEO signature is necessary ?
- * Yes, Your 7 years study certificate is to be counter signed by BEO to authenticate the certificate.
- 12** Is there any validity period for the caste & income certificate?
- * SC,ST/ Cat-1 Category certificates are valid till they are cancelled i.e this are for life time. In case of 2A,2B,3A,3B certificates they are valid for 5 years only from the date of issue .

Document Verification

1 When will you verify the documents?

- * After the result announcement the document verification schedule will be hosted, Rankwise & Datewise in the KEA website.
On the specified date/session the candidate has to attend for verification documents.

2 Where can candidate go for document verification?

- * The KEA has identified the nodal centres & the candidate can go to their any nearest nodal centres for verification of documents. (Except Clause code 'C' & 'D' should come & verify their documents in KEA Bangalore). This year KEA has established helpline centres in all district head quarters

3 Parents/ Guardian can come and verify their wards documents?

- * No, candidate is compulsory. However during emergency, authorities will permit the authorised persons.

4 Can candidates come & verify their documents other than his /her rank date/specified date?

- * No, candidates has to come & verify their documents on their scheduled date only. In emergency they can attend in other time, but not later than the last date.

5 During document verification do you issue any acknowledgement/ receipt?

- * After document verification, the verification slip will be issued by the verification officer in the nodal centre, which consists of submitted document list, and Secret Key. Compulsary the candidate should collect this verification slip.

6 What is Secret Key? How it is important?

- * Secret key is in 8 digit Alpha/Numerical in nature. Which can be used as User Id When the student log into to KEA website for Option entry. Which is students specific & unique number. Should not disclose to strangers /any other person.

Options Entry

1 What is a option entry ?

- * Option entry is a online seat selection process in which the candidate should enter their college code & course code name in the system to take a seat through non-interactive mode of seat selection in KEA .

2 Where can I enter options ?

- * KEA will release the option entry link in the KEA website after document verification. The candidate should click into the link & open the option entry sheet & you can enter your options.

3 Is there any Limitation to enter the option? Or How many options can I enter to take seat?

- * There is no limitation to enter the option, students can enter any number of options when you are giving options, you must prioritise the options & courses carefully.

4 What is prioritisation?

- * Prioritisation means when you are giving more than one option ,you must think which ones numbers to be put first & next. Always put most interested / desired collages/ courses to put first & then next.

5 Can I modify / change the options ?

- * Options can be entered within the given time schedule. After the given time there will be mock/trail allotment. After the mock allotment you can change your option/priority in the given schedule, after that no provision to change your priority.
